

FOR CERTIFICATE, GRADUATION AND POST-GRADUATION COURSES

Normal Admission upto 15th July or within 10 days from declaration of University/Board result of previous examination whichever is earlier.

- Regular classes will begin in the 1st week of July

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

1. Original and Photocopy of Certificates and marks sheets.
2. Copy of Aadhaar Card.
3. Original Date of Birth Certificate.
4. Character certificate from the Head of Institution last attended. (for new students)
5. Official certificate of category like SC/BC and Punjab Domicile.
6. All the supporting certificates from competent authorities in case of SC/BC/ST and low-income groups.
7. Original Migration & Eligibility Certificates.
8. 6 Passport size photographs

CHANGE IN SUBJECT

1. Students of TDC Part I or +1 may apply for the change of subject or stream within 15 days from the commencement of teaching.
2. To change the subject or stream, the student has to apply in the prescribed form within the mentioned time period on payment of prescribed fee.
3. Application for changing the subject or stream should be signed by the parents / guardians of the applicant.
4. The change if allowed will be at the risk of the student.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. The Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse or cancel admission to any student without assigning any reason.
2. Candidate, who has been placed under compartment in the Senior Secondary Examination Part II of PSEB or any other board may be allowed to join only BA/B.Sc.(Eco.) and B.Com. I and appear in the examination provisionally subject to his clearing the compartment in September.

3. Candidate, who has been placed under compartment in the Matriculation of PSEB or any other board may be allowed to join Senior Secondary Part I provisionally subject to his clearing the compartment in August.
4. Student selected for admission will be required to deposit 1st installment of the college dues on the day of admission.
5. Foreign national/NRIs must contact the college office before filling the application form for admission.
6. Admission of the student is purely provisional, subject to his/her registration with GNDU.
7. No student shall be admitted to any class even provisionally on the basis of a confidential result card of any board.
8. The College follows Rules & Procedures of Punjab Government while giving admissions to students for different reserved categories

ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

1. 75% of the attendance is mandatory according to university norms. In case of shortage the student will be detained.
2. Appearing in house tests & scoring minimum 25% marks in aggregate is mandatory. In case of medical emergency, the student has to get her leave sanctioned as per rules.
3. Since GNDU does not permit regular college students to be converted into private candidates, a student not fulfilling the University Examination eligibility conditions may lose one academic year.


