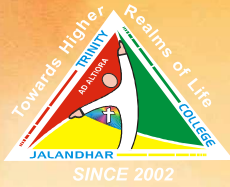

ELOCUTION

- The participant will recite a prepared poem or a speech in English.
- The time limit for the recitation is 3 min.
- The clock will start only when the participant recites the prepared speech/poem and not when the participant announces the title of the poem / speech
- The team would be required to submit a printed copy of the chosen verse quoting the source to the anchor person just before the turn of the participant comes.

SOLO DANCE (INDIAN/WESTERN)

- Weightage will be given to costume, presentation, synchronization and expression.
- Vulgarity is not allowed.
- Props are allowed.
- Participants bring their pre recorded CDs.

ON THE SPOT PAINTING, POSTER MAKING

- Participant will bring their own material.
- Sheet Size for all the events will be 22" x 15".
- Theme will be on "The Green Earth"

RANGOLI

- Size—3' x 3'
- Material to be used—Natural Colors, Flowers, Pulses, Rice etc.
- Topic for Rangoli will be related to environment and will be given on the spot.

COLLAGE

- The topic for collage will be related to environment and will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be using their own materials.
- Time limit is 1 hour.
- Paper cutting without scissor has to be done on the spot.
- Use of scissors for collage is not allowed.
- The collage will be assessed on the following points:
 - Composition- 25 points, Presentation- 25 points

AD-MAD SHOW

- One team comprising of three-five participants only
- Participant can choose their own theme
- Props are allowed
- Maximum time limit will be four to five minutes.

NET SAVVY

- Participants are to search relevant information regarding the topic given on the spot.
- Total time will be one hour. Internet facility will be given for half an hour to search the topic, and half an hour should be utilized for the preparation of the document.
- The size of content should be minimum 2 pages and maximum 4 pages.
- The prepared document should be saved in the team code folder by the participant.
- Relevance content and the format will be the major consideration.

DEBATE

- Topic will be given 24 hours before the competition.
- Two speakers will represent each team; one speaking for the motion and other against the motion.
- Each speaker will speak for 3 minutes.
- Warning bell will be rung after 2.5 minutes.
- Any inaccurate fact presented by the participant regarding the topic will get negative marks.
- A refutation round of 2 minutes will be held. The speaker will be expected to answer any question put up by the participants at that time.
- Straying off the topic will be penalized.

GENERAL RULES:

- ID Cards are compulsory for all students.
- One student can participate maximum in 3 events. Kindly check the schedule before enrollment.
- Overall winner trophy will be awarded and it will be based on the weighted score of all events.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
